The way Afghani writers present their nation on paper is absolutely breath-taking. Books by Afghani writers, both from Afghanistan and in the diaspora, especially those of Khaled Hosseini, splendidly portray the people and culture of Afghanistan. The people come out as living, breathing warriors, and not just mute victims. Their sorrows and their happiness are equally celebrated. 'Kite Runner' is one such beautiful book written by the fabulous writer Khalid Hosseini, which depicts the story of two boys in Afghanistan, and Afghan immigrants in America. It also explores the history of the rise of the Taliban in Afghanistan. The Kite Runner is set in Afghanistan during the Soviet military intervention. Amir and Hassan are the main protagonists of the story. The other characters of the story are Amir's father (Baba), Hassan's father (Ali). Amir and Hassan are best friends, notwithstanding the fact that Hassan and his father Ali work as servants in the house of Amir's father. They are young and apt to compete in kite competitions. One day, during the kite competition Hassan is bullied by Assef, who is envious of his talent to run down kites, and he beats and rapes Hassan. Amir being in the vicinity, could help his friend. However, he tries to ignore this scene and runs from that place. With the emergence of Russians in Afghanistan and with the start of the war, Amir with his father fled to San Francisco in the United States. However, his conscience does not leave him alone. He suffers from the guilt of his negligence towards his childhood friend. He returns to Afghanistan knowing about the disasters with Ali and Hassan. Amir finds in Kabul, the son of Hassan, Sohrab and tries to communicate with him. He also meets his wife. During the Taliban invasion they had killed Hassan and his wife and Sohrab was sent to camp. From there Amir saves him and takes him to the US. The book is really touching and creates a picture of lost hopes and the significance of duty in friendship. The book describes several themes. Some among them contemplate the themes of betrayal, choices, forgiveness, friendship, guilt, love, honour, immigrant experience, truth, class distinctions etc. The class difference which separated Amir and Hassan is the antagonist which caused Amir to ignore the needs and sufferings of Hassan. The story is fast-paced and hardly ever dull, and introduced me to a world - the world of Afghan life - which is strange, fascinating and yet oddly familiar all at the same time. Hosseini's writing finds a great balance between clarity and power. The story itself is brilliantly constructed, and explores the very art of storytelling.

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# ABDOMINAL MIGRAINE

Abdominal migraine is a variant of migraine primarily affecting children. It mainly causes episodes of abdominal pain without accompanying headache.

### SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS:

Abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, loss of appetite.

# **CAUSES:**

Common triggers may cause this. Psychological stress, poor sleep, exposure to bright light, and skipping meals can act as triggers.

# **DIAGNOSIS:**

There is no diagnostic test to identify abdominal migraines. It is diagnosed based on symptoms. Diagnosis is made based on family history of migraines and by eliminating other possible diseases.

# DIAGNOSTIC CRITERIA FROM THE INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATION OF HEADACHE DISORDERS:

A. At least 5 attacks fulfilling criteria B-D.

B. Attacks of abdominal pain lasting 1–72 hours (untreated or unsuccessfully treated)

C. Abdominal pain having all of the following characteristics:

- 1. Midline location, periumbilical or poorly localized
- 2. Dull or "just sore" quality
- 3. Moderate or severe intensity

D. Two of the following symptoms during episodes of abdominal pain:

- 1. Loss of appetite
- 2. Nausea
- 3. Vomiting
- 4. Pallor

E. Not attributed to another disorder.

### TREATMENT:

Short term treatment with analgesics. Pizotifen, propranolol may be used in rare cases.

### **PROGNOSIS:**

Abdominal migraine can have a significant impact on day-to-day life. Children may miss school or other activities. It resolves itself in many patients. Prognosis is generally good in children, but variable in adults.
