It was a multi-platform event organised by students with vertical and horizontal integration of medical knowledge from various branches. Here clinical experience was imparted alongside theoretical knowledge where students from various colleges across India wait eagerly to take part in.

There were 9 skills workshops: Basic Life Support, Surgical Skills, Obstetrics, Pulmonary Medicine, Pediatrics, Research Methodology, ECG and Ophthalmology. We witnessed enthusiastic participation from medical students

from various colleges along with many eager in-house registrations. In addition, were also con-

ducted 4 schools exhibitions namely by the department Anatomy, Pathology, Microbiology and FMT. A huge number
